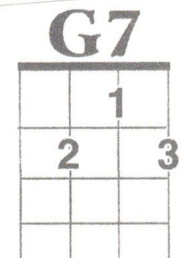
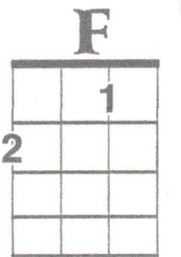
VERSE 1 and CHORUS 1:
