But uh-uh honey, lay off of my shoes.

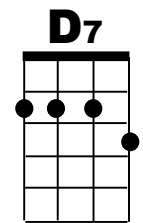
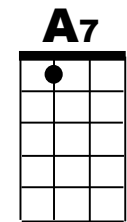
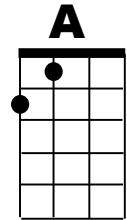

You can do an-y--thing but lay off of my blue suede shoes.

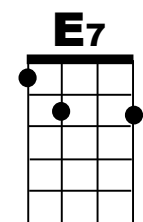
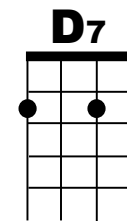
