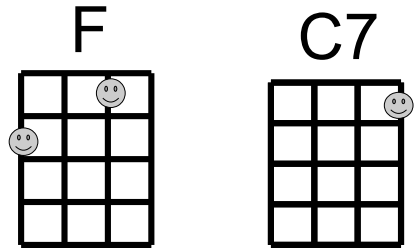


# Buffalo Gals
