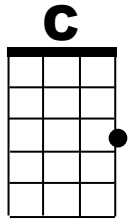


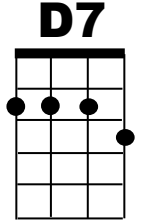
Catch a Falling Star

^G Save it for a rainy day ^{Gsus G}

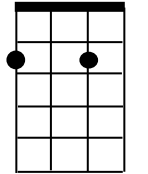


^C For love may come and tap you on the shoulder

 You'll have a pocketful of starlight



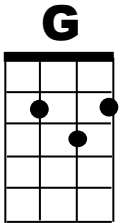
