oo oo oo-oo oo-oo-oooo Be happy. oo oo oo-oo-oooo Don't worry, be happy.

C C Dm Dm
Ain't got no place to lay your head? Somebody came and took your bed?

F F C C
Don't worry, be happy.

C C Dm Dm
The landlord says your rent is late; he may have to litigate.

F F C
Don't worry. Ha-ha ha-ha ha! Be happy.

Look at me I'm happy.

Dm F F C C
