Well, it's all right -- as long as you got somewhere to lay.

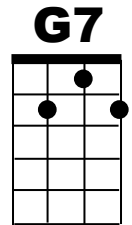
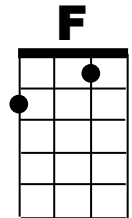
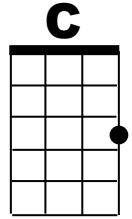
