

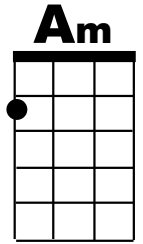

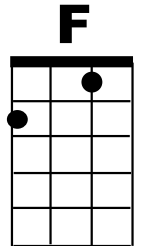
Intro: Am G Am G

CALYPSO STRUM: DDU UDU

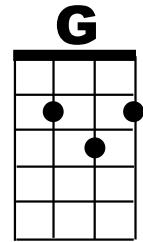
Am G Am G
