

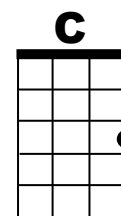
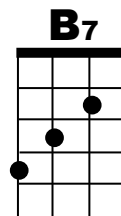
# Hallelujah in the key of G

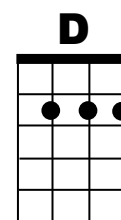
**INTRO: G Em G Em**

**STRUM: D D U - U D U**

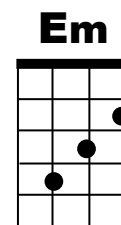
**Verse 1:** Now I've heard there was a secret chord,

**(4) (4) (4)**

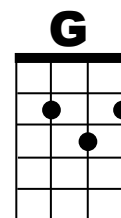


**Verse 2:** Your faith was strong but you needed proof
