There in the moon mist

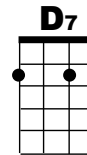
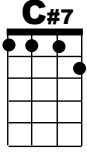
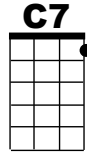
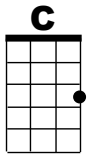
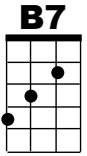
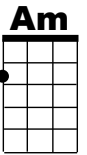
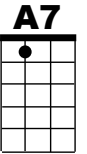
**BRIDGE** F E7 A7 D7 G7 C7 B7 E7
