True love and homegrown tomatoes.

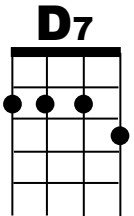
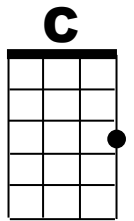
^G There's nothin' in the world that I like better

CHORUS:

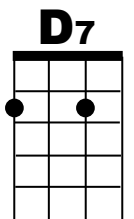
^G You can go out to eat and that's for sure
