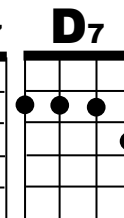
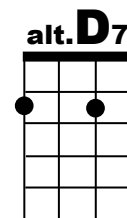
I dig -- rock and roll music, and I love to get the chance to play -- (and sing it)

 But hey! -- It feels so groovy to sa.....ay.



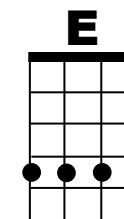
I dig -- the Mamas and the Papas at "The Trip," -- Sunset strip in L.A.
