

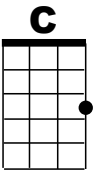
# Leaving on a Jet Plane, Key of C...

John Denver, 1966 and made famous by Peter, Paul and Mary

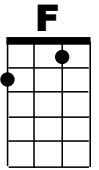
**Intro:** C F C G7 C  
4 4 2 2 1

**Lazy, but not too lazy swing strum**



*Kathy sings,*  
*We strum* C F C G7 C  
All my bags are packed, I'm ready to go, I'm standing here out-side your door.  
I hate to wake you up to say good-bye.

C F C G7 C  
But the dawn is breaking, It's early morn, the taxi's waiting, he's blowing his horn  
Al-ready I'm so lone-some I could die.



**CHORUS:** C F C F  
*We all sing and strum* C F G7 C  
So kiss me and smile for me, tell me that you'll wait for me  
Hold me like you'll never let me go.  
'Cause I'm leaving on a jet plane,  
*soft* C F C  
Don't know when I'll be back a-gain.  
*louder* F G7
