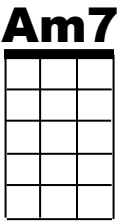


# Rhythm of the Rain

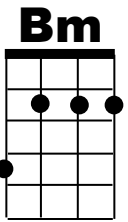

**Intro: C(4) G(4) C(4) G(4)**

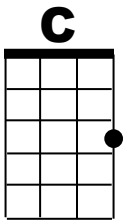
**G** Listen to the rhythm of the falling rain, telling me just what a fool I've been.  
**G** I wish that it would go and let me cry in vain, and let me be a-lone a-gain.



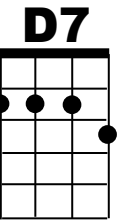
**G** The only girl I care about has gone away, lookin' for a brand new start.  
**G** But little does she know that when she left that day, a-long with her she took my heart.



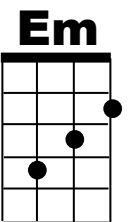
**C** Rain please tell me now does that seem fair

**Em** I can't love another when my heart's somewhere far away.



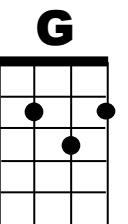
