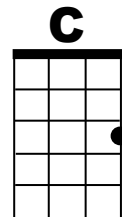


Ring of Fire

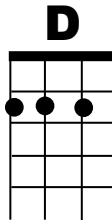
Made famous by Johnny Cash; first two verses attributed to June Carter

6 2 6 2

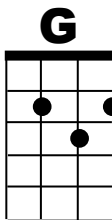
VERSE # 1 ^G Love is a ^C burnin' ^G thing,

CHORUS: ^D I fell into a ^C burnin' ^G ring of fire
I went ^D down, down, down
And the flames went higher,
^G And it burns, burns, burns,
The ring of fire, the ring of fire. ^{C(2) G C(2) G (4 + 4)}



VERSE # 2 ^G The taste of love is sweet
When hearts like ^C ours ^G meet.
I fell for you like a child.
Oh, but the ^C fire ^G ran wild.



CHORUS:

VERSE # 3 ^G The touch of fire is hot.
Thank you, Doug Banta It burns without a thought.
Our love is ^C more than ^G warm.
It glows like a fiery storm.

CHORUS:

VERSE # 4 ^G As the flames begin to fade,
Thank you, Jean Russell My breath, on ^C embers ^G made,
Finds love is ^C sparked ^G again.
