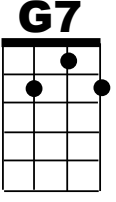
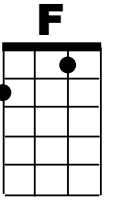
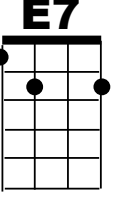
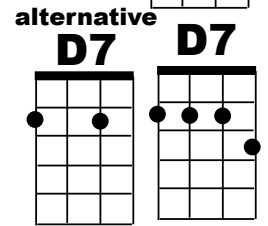
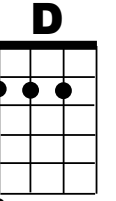
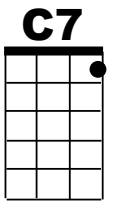
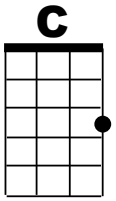
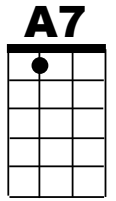
1) I got the blues from my baby livin' by the San Francisco Bay.
