**Verse 1** C (walk down) D7 G7 C G7  
 Hey, walk right in.....set ri--ight.....down, and baby let your mind roll on.....  
 C (walk down) D7 G7  
 Hey, walk right in....they don't know why.....cuz' Daddy, you been stayin' too long.  
 C Am7 C C Am7 C  
 Now, every-body's talkin' 'bout a new way o' walkin'  
 C...TACIT..... A7  
 Do you want to lose your mind  
 C (walk down) D7 G7 C G7  
 Hey, walk right in.....set ri--ight....down.....and Daddy, let your mind roll on.....

**Verse 2** C (walk down) D7 G7 C G7  
 Hey, walk right in.....set ri--ight .....down.....and baby let your mind roll on.....  
 C (walk down) D7 G7  
 Hey, walk right in.....stay a little.... while.....but Daddy, you been stayin' too long.  
 C Am7 C Am7 C Am7 C  
 Now, everybody's talkin' 'bout a new way o' walkin'  
 C...TACIT..... A7  
 Do you want to lose your mind?  
 C (walk down) A7 D7 G7 C G7

**ENDING:**

C (walk down) A7 D7 G7 C A7  
 Hey, walk right in.....set ri--ight .... down.....and Daddy, let your mind roll on.....

**RITARD (s-l-o-w)** .....And Daddy, let your mind roll on.....  
 D7 G7 C(1)

**Walk Down:**

Slide finger on A string from 3rd fret to first fret and then no fret, creating a four note "walkdown."  
 This sounds pretty cool!
