

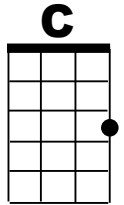

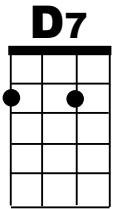

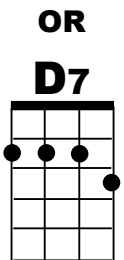
We'd like to build the world a home, and furnish it with love,
Grow apple trees and honey bees, and snow-white turtle doves.



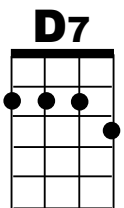
We'd like to teach the world to sing in perfect harmony.

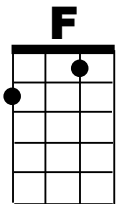

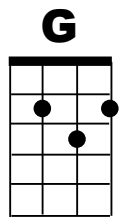

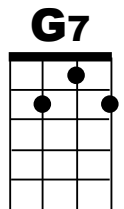
